Managing the power supply with without battery backup

You have chosen to have a NBN Power Supply without Battery Backup installed with your Commander or Key Phone Voice Services. Please make sure you read all the information below and understand your rights and responsibilities.

WITHOUT BATTERY BACKUP

- › During a power outage, NBN-based services, including telephone and data services will not work in the event of a power failure.
- › No emergency calls can be placed during a power outage without a battery backup for your NBN services.
- › It is your responsibility to always have an alternative means of contacting someone during a power outage in case of an emergency such as a charged mobile phone.
- › If you agree to have a Power Supply without Battery Backup, the battery should be removed from the Power Supply with Battery Backup.
